

SPP Indicator C-4 (Family Outcomes) Probe Questions

Common Indicator Probe Questions

1. Do you have new data or new information that is more current than the data shown on your Strand Report? If so, what do the data show?
2. How does your performance level compare to the State target?
3. Do the data vary significantly based on child's race/ethnicity?
4. Do the data vary significantly based on child's age?
5. Do the data vary significantly based on a child's *Early On*[®] eligibility category?
6. Does the performance level reflect a **systemic** problem (e.g., it involves multiple classrooms, buildings, providers, personnel changes, or processes), or is it **clustered** in specific buildings, or with providers or groups of students?
7. Have the data shown any significant changes over time?

Indicator-Specific Probe Questions

1. What does your family survey data say about your local program?
2. Are there policies, procedures, practices in place to address the family outcomes?
3. Do your local *Early On*[®] providers routinely distribute and explain the procedural safeguards to families?
4. Do your families participate in the evaluation of the functioning of their child?
5. Is the IFSP designed to increase the family's capacity to meet the developmental needs of the child?
6. Have you prepared your personnel to address the family outcomes in your community?
